


St. Mary's Catholic School

### OUR STAFF FOR 2021-2022

I would like to welcome each of our wonderful staff back for another exciting year of education at St. Mary's. I am really thrilled to have such a varied and talented team of educators to work with this year. Ms. Garden will be teaching Kindergarten this year while Mrs. Maclean is on maternity leave. Mrs. Brown will be teaching grade 2 on Thursdays while Ms. Vandermeer works for the Diocese as a Christian Education consultant. ### FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL

School begins for all classes (K-7) on Tuesday, September 7<sup>th</sup> starting at **8:20 am** and ending at **2:20 pm** for all students. Upon arrival, students will be welcomed to play outside. **Kindergarten to grade 3** will be on the Freeman street playground side, and **grades 4-7** will be on the Gillett St. side. This will ensure students are spaced out and able to enter the school from different areas.

### **PARKING LOT SAFETY**

We ask that you drop off and pick up your children from outside the school parking lot. **Please remember that vehicles are NOT PERMITTED to be on the school grounds at any time.** It is for the safety of our children.

### **DISCIPLINE AND TECHNOLOGY USAGE**

A form will go out during the first week regarding our discipline and computer usage policy. This is to be signed by the parents and each child and sent back during the second week of classes. A reminder that cell phones, iPod's etc. are not to be used during school hours. They must remain in your child's back pack. All communication with home should be done through the school office. Thank you.

### **VOLUNTEERS AND CRIMINAL RECORD CHECKS**

To ensure student safety and to continue to have great volunteers, ALL volunteers need to have on file:

- A completed volunteer application form
- A criminal record check

Criminal Record Checks are available to be done online. More information is available on our website. All visitors must sign-in at the school office.

### **UNIFORM INFORMATION**

The school uniform is compulsory for all grade 1-7 students at our school. It is required that students wear only what is listed in the dress code. Contact the school for more info. Uniforms can be ordered from Cambridge Uniforms using the link found on the school website.

**NOT PERMITTED AS PART OF THE SCHOOL UNIFORM:** jogging pants, cargo pants, jeans, large noticeable jewelry, & make-up. Leggings may only be worn under skirts or tunics.

### **CALENDAR**

A current calendar for the 2021-2022 year is attached. The calendar is also available on our website. If there are any changes it will be changed on the newsletters that get sent home or online. The first change is that our first school mass will not be until October as Fr. Gilbert will be away. Information will be sent home as soon as it is available.

### DAILY HEALTH CHECKS

Parents are responsible for assessing their children daily for illness before sending them to school. You can use the [K-12 Health Check app](#) for daily assessment of symptoms. If a student is sick, they must not enter the school. Thank you for your diligence in keeping our community healthy!

### MASKS & PPE

All students in grades 4-12 are required to wear a mask or a face shield indoors in schools and on school buses. Students in kindergarten to grade 3 are encouraged to wear a mask but are not required to do so. All visitors must wear a non-medical mask when they are inside the school.

### LATES OR ABSENTS

All students are expected to be here by the first bell at 8:20am. Thank you for ensuring our school day starts off on time and with no disruption to classes. If your son or daughter is absent, please call the school and then send a note to the office when they return. There are blank notes available on our website as well as in your student's planner.

### SUPPLY FEES AND TUITION

Each student will be charged a \$100 supply fee to help cover the cost of paper, agenda's, and consumables. **This fee must be paid by Oct.1<sup>st</sup>, 2021.** E-transfers are now accepted! Supply Fees and Tuition can be paid online on our website or at the office with debit, credit, cash, cheque, or e-transfer. Thank you.
