
SEPTEMBER 2021 NEWSLETTER

<u>Uniform</u> - All grades 1-7 must wear the school uniform.

Girls: Light blue crested polo shirt, light blue blouse, navy blue crested sweater, royal blue crested vest, or fleece.

Grey tunic, dress pants, skirt or walking shorts.

Boys: Light blue crested polo shirt, light blue dress shirt, navy blue crested sweater, royal blue crested vest, or fleece.

Grey dress pants, cords or walking shorts. For ordering information please contact the office or see the school website.

<u>Terry Fox Run</u> – This will take place Friday, October 1st. Students and staff will walk or jog around a scheduled route for at least 30 minutes. Pledge forms will be sent home with the students. Students can wear their blue husky t-shirts to school.

<u>Husky t-shirts</u> – Last year PSG provided every student and staff member with a new Husky t-shirt! This year, every new student will receive a Husky t-shirt. They are not part of the uniform but we will have days throughout the year that students are welcome to wear their Husky t-shirt. Thank you PSG! If you are looking to purchase a shirt this year (\$10 each), check with the office for availability of sizes.

Read Around the House – This program sponsored by our PSG encourages students to read (or be read to) each day. Students will then write/draw about a book they read. At the end of the month a book draw takes place for one of the participating students. Look for your child's reading program in his or her agenda.

<u>Tuition & Supply Fee</u> – Tuition can be paid all at once via credit card, debit, cheque or cash or monthly installments. The \$100 supply fee per student is payable by October 1st. The supply fee is to help with the costs of the children's planners, consumable workbooks, photo copying and art supplies.

<u>Criminal Record Checks/Volunteer Form</u> – Parents and/or guardians must have a criminal record check on file and **volunteer form** if they want to participate in a field trip with any class.
